Recommendations of the State Level Start-up Council of Tripura Startup in the 1st Meeting of the Council held on 14th and 15th May, 2025

The 1st Meeting of the State Level Start-up Council for the Tripura Start-up Policy 2024 was convened under the chairmanship of the Secretary, IT, on 14th and 15th May 2025. The Council reviewed 17 new project proposals for start-up recognition, evaluated proposals from three educational institutions seeking enrollment under the NGIN scheme and evaluated T-Hubs proposal for engagement as "Knowledge Partner" (additional agenda added during the meeting due to emerging requirement).

- Agenda: 1. Evaluation of proposals from Educational Institutes for on-boarding under NGIN Scheme
 - 2. Evaluation of project proposals for Start-Up recognition.
 - 3. Engagement of T-Hub (Premier Institution for Startups) as "Knowledge Partner".

During the meeting, representatives from all 17(seventeen) start-ups and 3(three) educational institutions appeared before the Council to present their proposals. The Council members engaged actively with the presenters, raising various queries, which were addressed comprehensively by the respective representatives.

III. Engagement of "Knowledge Partner: T-Hub is one of India's premier innovation hubs and startup incubators, based in Hyderabad. It is known for its strong support system that connects startups with mentors, investors, industry experts, and academic institutions, while also offering strategic guidance, funding access, and market linkages. Engagement with T-Hub will help strengthen the startup ecosystem in Tripura and support the growth of scalable startups through the sector agnostic Tripura Startup Policy, 2024. This proposal was discussed in the State Level Council meeting, and the Council recommended signing the MoU with T-Hub for engagement as "Knowledge Partner.

After detailed discussions, the Council recommended for considering proposals of the 10 (ten) startups: (1) Atkalapa Biotechnology LLP (2) HN Technovations (3) Medilipse (4) Picknaldo Ventures Privade Limited (5) Rnj Agriclinic and Agribusiness Pvt Ltd (6) 7 Ocean centre of music (7) aAHARAN EduSMART Pvt. Ltd (8) Bambucult Industries Private Limited (9) EV360 (10) Datalet Research Laboratory Pvt. Ltd. The council also recommended considering the proposals of all 3 educational institutes: (1) The Aryavart International University (2) National Forensic Sciences University (3) College of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry for NGIN enrollment.

With regard to the following 7 (seven) startups (1) Dipsa Enterprises Private Limited (2) Jatiya Sevashram Foundation (3) Verdara Naturtain Private Limited (4) Bishma Drone Solution Private Limited (5) Bluconnect Innovations Private Limited (6) Institute of Investment Training (7) Pilix technologies private limited — the Council observed certain gaps in their current level of preparedness. Accordingly, it was advised that these startups revisit and refine their proposals, and present their revised ideas at the next Council meeting with improved clarity and readiness. Detailed observations of Start-up Council are given in *Annexure-I*.
