

Recommendations of the State Level Start-up Council of Tripura Startup in the 1st Meeting of the Council held on 14th and 15th May, 2025

The 1st Meeting of the State Level Start-up Council for the **Tripura Start-up Policy 2024** was convened under the chairmanship of the Secretary, IT, on 14th and 15th May 2025. The Council reviewed 17 new project proposals for start-up recognition, evaluated proposals from three educational institutions seeking enrollment under the NGIN scheme and evaluated T-Hubs proposal for engagement as “Knowledge Partner” (additional agenda added during the meeting due to emerging requirement).

Agenda: 1. Evaluation of proposals from Educational Institutes for on-boarding under NGIN Scheme
2. Evaluation of project proposals for Start-Up recognition.
3. Engagement of T-Hub (Premier Institution for Startups) as “Knowledge Partner”.


During the meeting, representatives from all 17(seventeen) start-ups and 3(three) educational institutions appeared before the Council to present their proposals. The Council members engaged actively with the presenters, raising various queries, which were addressed comprehensively by the respective representatives.



III. Engagement of “Knowledge Partner: T-Hub is one of India’s premier innovation hubs and startup incubators, based in Hyderabad. It is known for its strong support system that connects startups with mentors, investors, industry experts, and academic institutions, while also offering strategic guidance, funding access, and market linkages. Engagement with T-Hub will help strengthen the startup ecosystem in Tripura and support the growth of scalable startups through the sector agnostic Tripura Startup Policy, 2024. This proposal was discussed in the State Level Council meeting, and the Council recommended signing the MoU with T-Hub for engagement as “Knowledge Partner.


After detailed discussions, the Council recommended for considering proposals of the 10 (ten) startups: (1) Atkalapa Biotechnology LLP (2) HN Technovations (3) Medilipse (4) Picknaldo Ventures Privade Limited (5) Rnj Agriclinic and Agribusiness Pvt Ltd (6) 7 Ocean centre of music (7) aAHARAN EduSMART Pvt. Ltd (8) Bambucult Industries Private Limited (9) EV360 (10) Datalet Research Laboratory Pvt. Ltd. The council also recommended considering the proposals of all 3 educational institutes: (1) The Aryavart International University (2) National Forensic Sciences University (3) College of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry for NGIN enrollment.


With regard to the following 7 (seven) startups (1) Dipsa Enterprises Private Limited (2) Jatiya Sevashram Foundation (3) Verdara Naturtain Private Limited (4) Bishma Drone Solution Private Limited (5) Bluconnect Innovations Private Limited (6) Institute of Investment Training (7) Pilix technologies private limited — the Council observed certain gaps in their current level of preparedness. Accordingly, it was advised that these startups revisit and refine their proposals, and present their revised ideas at the next Council meeting with improved clarity and readiness. 




Annexure-I

Sl.No.	Name of the Start-up	Observations of the State Level Start-up Council in the meeting held on 14 th and 15 th May, 2025
1	Atkalapa Biotechnology LLP	The startup offers wellness products rooted in biotechnology. The Council advised exploring customer segments in Tier 2/3 cities, improving packaging, and narrowing the product range. The Council recommended issuance of the recognition certificate.
2	Dipsa Enterprises Private Limited	The startup aims to manufacture detergents in small-sized packets for cost-sensitive consumers. The Council raised concerns about the startup's competitive advantage over established brands, found limited differentiation beyond pricing, and reviewed the survey methodology and revenue model. The Council advised refining the USP and re-presenting a revised business plan in the next Council Meeting.
3	HN Technovations	The startup provides portable water purification solutions with quality monitoring. The Council was apprised about the expansion opportunities and recommended issuance of the recognition certificate.
4	Jatiya Sevashram Foundation	The startup offers mobile healthcare services in rural areas. The Council noted ambiguity in the referral model, particularly regarding private hospital linkages, and advised clarifying its hiring strategy and integration with government health schemes. The Council directed the startup to revise its plan and re-present in the next Council Meeting.
5	Medilipse	The startup is engaged in medicine delivery and aims to expand into broader healthcare services. The Council reviewed demand-supply data, revenue model, and return policy. The Council recommended issuance of the recognition certificate.
6	Picknaldo Ventures Private Limited	The startup focuses on packaged food delivery. The Council reviewed licensing, hygiene standards, and competitors and suggested inclusion of additional fruit varieties. The Council recommended issuance of the recognition certificate.
7	Rnj Agriclinc and Agribusiness Pvt. Ltd.	The startup produces fiber from organic residues. The Council discussed the unit cost, partnership status, and technical details and found to have potential growth opportunities. The Council recommended issuance of the recognition certificate.
8	Verdara Naturtain Private Limited	The startup promotes organic farming. The Council inquired about differentiation from government initiatives and the timeline for soil preparation. The Council observed gaps in the interim execution plan and directed the startup to detail its operations and to re-present in the next Council Meeting.
9	7 Ocean Centre of Music	The startup delivers music education and services via an app. The Council reviewed customer base, revenue, and profitability, and advised exploring industry affiliations. The Council recommended issuance of the recognition certificate.
10	aAHARAN EduSMART Pvt. Ltd	The startup provides app-based e-learning solutions. The Council reviewed funding sources, cash burn, and sustainability. The Council recommended issuance of the recognition certificate.
11	Bambucult Industries Private Limited	The startup manufactures bamboo-based lifestyle products, employing artisans. The Council reviewed purchase orders and advised obtaining relevant certifications. The Council recommended issuance of the recognition certificate.
12	Bishma Drone Solution Private Limited	The startup aims to establish a drone manufacturing facility. The Council reviewed technical and licensing details but found the business model lacking commercial viability. The Council advised revisiting the cost model, market demand, and scalability, and directed the startup to re-present in the next Council Meeting.
13	Bluconnect Innovations	The startup serves as an aggregator for blue-collar jobs, currently handling ~50 jobs/day. The Council found critical

	Private Limited	readiness issues, including absence of a website, and advised improving operational preparedness and competitor analysis. The Council directed to represent the revise proposal in the next Council Meeting.
14	Datalet Research Laboratory Pvt. Ltd	The startup develops multilingual AI-based chatbots. The Council assessed the technology, expenditures, and server usage. The Council recommended issuance of the recognition certificate.
15	EV360	The startup provides electric vehicle servicing. The Council evaluated operating locations, customer data, and team size. The Council recommended issuance of the recognition certificate.
16	Institute of Investment Training	The startup uses mnemonics to improve learning. The Council noted the lack of a productized format and advised translating the methodology into scalable digital tools. The Council directed the startup to re-present its plan in the next Council Meeting.
17	Pilix Technologies Private Limited	The startup offers IT and BPO sector training. The Council reviewed licensing, certifications, and placement viability, and expressed concerns over scalability, specifically the idea of converting learners into employees. The council also questioned the feasibility of user preference for online training from local vs external providers. The Council advised refining the placement model, demonstrating demand clarity and re-present in the next Council Meeting.
